Estes Park, CO (July 26, 2009): Rocky Ridge Music Center invites the public to a marathon of solo & chamber student recitals beginning July 29th to 31st @ 3 p.m. & 7 p.m. culminating with the orchestra concert presenting Young Artist Seminar Concerto Winners--cellist Caroline Kim (Calgary, AB); violinist Kate Richert (London, ON) on Saturday, August 1st at 3 p.m. Caroline will perform the Tchaikovsky Nocturne Op. 10, No. 4 and Kate will perform the Barber Violin Concerto conducted by maestro Adam Flatt on Saturday, August 1 at 3 p.m. All concerts will take place at the Rocky Ridge Music Center Concert Hall located on 465 Longs Peak Rd. in Estes Park, Colorado. The concerts are free and open to the public.



Rocky Ridge Music Center, founded in 1942 by pianist Beth Miller Harrod, is one of the oldest residential summer music programs in the country. It is located at the foot of Longs Peak (14,256 ft.) in the heart of Rocky Mountain National Park. The historic Hewes-Kirkwood Inn and cabins on 17 acres with a stream provide a stunning backdrop for performances, practice, lessons, chamber music, reflection, dining, residence and friendships. Rocky Ridge summer programs for youth (ages 10 to 24) and adults are designed to improve and broaden musical skills in areas of strings, woodwinds, brass, piano and voice through solo, chamber, orchestral, and theory/composition studies, all under the guidance of a world-class faculty and guest artists.
